
Library as 3rd Space

'You should expect your library to be a community space – a place for the interchange of ideas and the creation of whole new concepts.'(Lankes, 2012)




























A LIBRARY IS NOT JUST A REFERENCE SERVICE: IT IS A PLACE FOR THE VUNERABLE.
