

#### DEFENCE COMMITTEE REPORT.

AUSTRALIAN BOOK TRADE ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

The object of the Defence Committee in arranging its meeting the day prior to the Federal A.B.T.A.C. meeting was to discuss in detail the conclusions and implications of the joint report submitted by Counsel, allied to this report was that of the P.A's opinion and recommendations which stemmed from the Counsel's report. Under the terms of reference the Defence Committee was instructed to make recommendations to A.B.T.A.C. as to the most satisfactory method of implementing the revision necessary in order to present a document, or documents, which could be registered under the Trade Practices Bill.

In summarising decisions leading to the recommendations effecting the Statement of Terms, and other documents, it is proposed to present these factors under four main headings :-

- (1) Charter of the P.A.C.
- (2) Counsel's report on the Trade Practices Bill. P.A's report on the joint opinion.
- (3) Statement of Terms.
- (4) Statistics.

P.A.C. CHARTER: Counsel and the P.A. confirm that the various documents of our trade are registrable and that existing agreements have to be registered, not only those which come into agreement after the Act.

It was therefore agreed that the first document to receive attention should be the P.A.C. Charter; this being the original document of arrangements concerning the Australian Book-trade. Listed therein are the respective agreements covering the original Statement of Terms, Schedule of Retail Prices, Trade Register, P.A. committee and its functions, etc ..

TENDERING: Counsel recommends that the trade should consider its position as early as possible and consequently to revise the documents to a degree where they can be defended.

Although the word "Tender" is mentioned briefly in the S. of T. (machinery clause 3) the actual regulations are stipulated in a composite memorandum originating from P.A.C. Minutes 12(5); 14(12G); 11(3) and returning to the S. of T, Clauses 3, 7 and machinery Clause 2.


In following the tendering regulations to the letter it was

agreed that adherence to the above did constitute "collusive" tendering within the meaning of the Bill and furthermore as the present tendering clauses were being disregarded they were non-effective. 




